Thank you for contacting my Albany office urging support for Assembly Bill A.8655, which, if enacted, would require commuter railroads operating outside the city of New York to have a crew of at least two qualified persons, exclusive of the locomotive engineer. I understand your concern with this issue and appreciate hearing your views.

At times, trains operate with as many as eight passenger cars that make operation with a single train person dangerous and places the safety and well being of passengers at risk. This legislation would bolster the security and well being of hundreds and thousands of commuters each day. I will certainly support the measure should it come before me on the Assembly floor for a full house vote.
